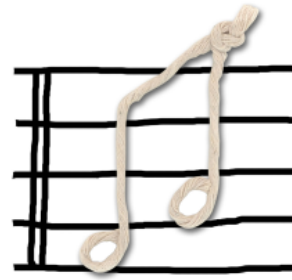


# Love music?

You'll be given the creative scope to develop and advertise the area and to build up a reputation in your local area. This is an exciting opportunity to be part of a new project which, if successful will be rolled out across the rest of the UK. Save the Children charity shops bring in £6 million each year which goes towards our work with disadvantaged children in the UK and overseas and we hope to increase this figure by improving music areas in our existing shops.

### What does the role involve?

- Sorting donations of music and categorising into different genres (dance, hip hop, chart, classical etc)
- Pricing CDs/ vinyls according to their condition
- Reviewing albums with other volunteers and displaying reviews in area
- Forming relationships with local music retailers/record stations to encourage donations of surplus/seconds stock
- Building up collection of CDs from local signed and unsigned bands
- Creating attractive displays and keeping music area organised
- Finding ways to encourage music donations from local community
- Helping out with other tasks within the shop where necessary
- Ensuring other volunteers understand how to run the music area so it runs efficiently in your absence
