

CRAFTY CREATIONS IDEAS

PAPIER MÂCHÉ

Papier mâché is not only great fun, you can also make pretty much anything out of it. Consider making models of the activities you like doing with friends, like football, or have a go at crafting your best friend's face.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Water
- Flour
- Paper (old newspapers are perfect)
- A paintbrush
- Colourful paints
- Wipeable surface or plastic sheeting

MOBILES

Mobiles look fantastic in school halls or classrooms and are very cheap and easy to make. Why not make a mobile of items that can help save a child's life? The friendship gift ladder should give you plenty of inspiration!

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- String
- Paper, cardboard, egg boxes
- Paint or colouring pencils
- Bamboo cane or dowel rod
- Glue
- Metal or wooden pin to attach to ceiling

PHOTOGRAPHY & FILM

At Save the Children, we make lots of films about our work. You could do the same! Work together to script and film a short movie about child rights, or take a series of pictures of you and your friends out and about, doing the stuff you enjoy.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- A handheld camcorder, digital camera, disposable camera or some mobile phones

MOSAICS

Work together with your friends to choose a theme for your mosaic, such as what makes friendships special or the lives of children around the world. You could do your own smaller mosaic, or a section each as part of a larger project. To get the best results, try sketching your ideas on paper first!

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Chalk or crayon
- Paper
- Strong glue, such as PVA
- Material for the 'tiles' – you could use foam, ceramic tiles, buttons or glass (if you're very careful!)
- A backing surface
