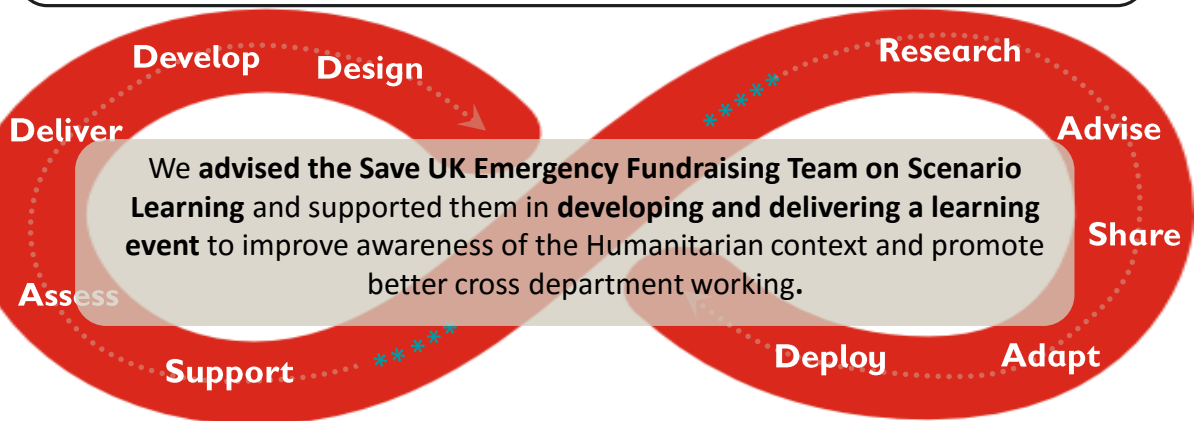
### Mission Statement
