

Scones are a very popular British cake.

Here's a recipe to make your own!



SCONES → THE BRITISH STAPLE:

350g self raising flour
1 tsp baking powder
85g butter (in cubes)
3 tbsp caster sugar
175 ml milk
beaten egg
Jam + clotted cream (to serve)



- oven at 220°c, mix flour, a pinch of salt, and baking powder
- add butter, rub in with fingers till it looks like crumbs
- mix milk and some vanilla extract, then mix with dry mixture
- cut with a 5cm cutter
- brush tops with beaten egg, and bake for 10 mins
- cut in half and cover with cream and jam! ENJOY

pacific

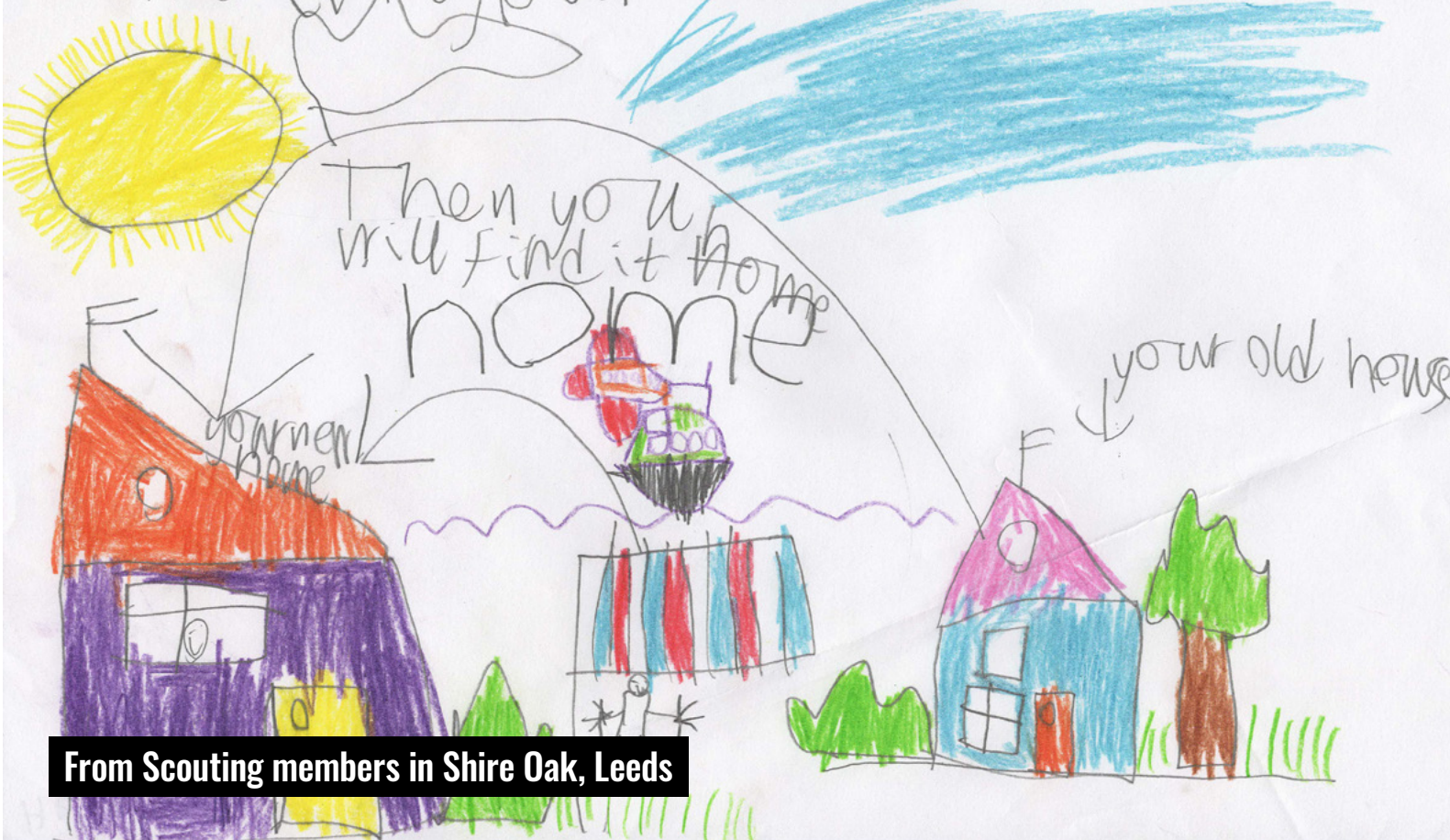

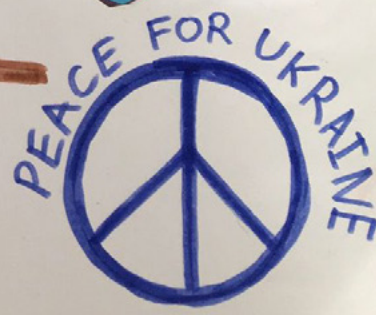

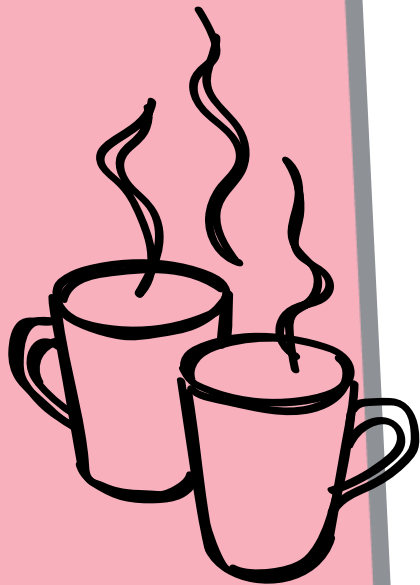


Hi! It's nice to meet you, I'm Ace

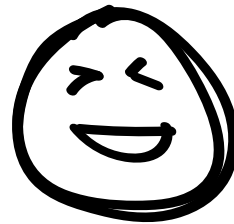

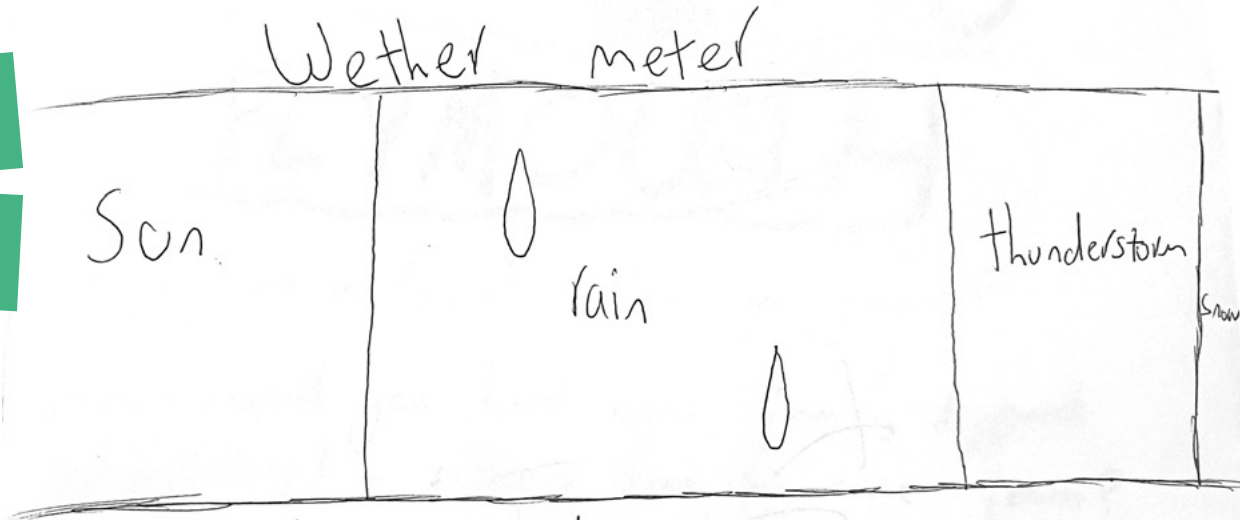

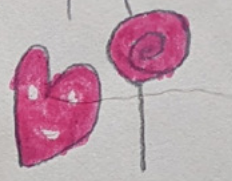
